

School Uniform.

Please see the information about our school uniform. Uniform can be purchased from Elite Embroidery. https://eliteembroidery.co.uk/education/schools/st-cuthberts-primary-school/

The following school uniform must be worn in school.

- Navy blue cardigan or navy blue sweatshirt (with the school logo);
- Mid grey trousers; or mid grey skirt/pinafore. Tracksuit bottoms and leggings are not considered suitable (except when wearing PE Kit – see below);
- Skirt length should be on or below the knee. The style of skirt should not hug the figure.
- Short grey trousers (optional during the summer term);
- Blue/white checked dresses (optional during the summer term);
- Sun hat (summer term);
- White polo shirt * (with or without the school logo);
- All black school shoes. Heels are not considered suitable;
- Socks white, black, grey or navy-blue socks (dark socks with trousers);
- Tights -navy blue, grey or black plain opaque tights. Patterned or lacy tights are not permitted; and
- A blue school book bag * (with the school logo).

PE Kits

- Pupils are expected to wear the following PE kit on their allocated PE days:-
- House colour t-shirt * (with the school logo);
- Navy blue PE hoody * (with or without the school logo is optional, school sweatshirt can be worn outside in cold weather instead)
- Black shorts;

- Navy blue or black tracksuit joggers or, black sports leggings (without school logo, or "sports" branding or corporate logo);
- Black plimsolls for indoors;
- Black trainers for outdoors;

No football strips are to be worn for PE.

Nail extensions, gel manicures and pierced ears are not permitted for Health and Safety purposes.

After School Clubs

Please note that there will be no extra curricular after school clubs in the final week of term. Cuthbert's Beads will be running as usual.

Holidays during term time cannot be authorised. The Local Authority may issue a Fixed Penalty Notice for unauthorised absences.
