What will I be learning?

- **Ask and respond** to questions about being chosen.
- **Ask questions** about what they and others wonder about the reason for responses to being chosen.
- **Retell** some special stories about religious events and people such as David and/ or the call of the apostles.
- Use religious words and phrases to **describe** what it means to be called.
- **Describe** some ways in which people are called to live a Christian life.
- **Make links** between scripture and the call to holiness.
- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs can affect the responses they might make to being chosen.
- Use a **developing religious vocabulary** to **give reasons** for the actions and symbols used at Confirmation.
- **Give reasons** why and how Christians respond to God 's call.

Oil of Chrism	A special oil used during Baptism and Confirmation.
Mitre	A headdress worn by a Bishop.
Crozier	A hooked staff carried by a Bishop as a symbol of pastoral office.
Sponsor	A person who provides support for an individual.
Catechist	A teacher of the principles of Christianity.
Bishop	A senior member of the clergy, in charge of priests and deacons.
Holy Spirit	God as spiritually active in the world.
witness	A person who has seen an event occur.
anointing	To smear or rub with oil as part of a sacrament.
Holy Trinity	God in three parts; God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
enkindle	To inspire or arouse emotion.
called	To be asked by name to do something.
