### What should I already know?

#### What will I be learning?

- Ask and respond to questions about their own and others' experiences and feelings about homes.
- **Ask questions** about what they and others wonder about what makes a house a home and realise that sometimes this is a difficult question to answer.
- **Retell** some of the advice offered by Paul in his letters about living together as a family and the life of the Holy Family.
- **Describe** some ways Christians live as people chosen by God.
- **Ask questions** about what they and others wonder about how God is always with us, and realise that this is a difficult question to answer.
- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect how they, their behaviour and that of others in relation to the give and take of living in a family.
- **Compare** their own and other people's ideas about the difficult question of what make a house a home.
- **Make links** between some scripture they have studied and the belief that God can make a difference in everyday life through God's unchanging love.
- **Give reasons** why Christians should try to love others.
- **Compare** their own and others' ideas about what they and others wonder about how God is always with us, and realise that some questions are difficult to answer.
