What things are better done together?

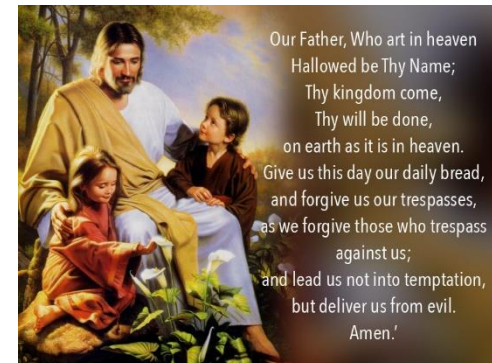
Why are they better with others?

### Key Words

<b>Welcome</b>	How we greet someone in a friendly way.
<b>Blessing</b>	A feeling when you know God is taking care of you and protecting you.
<b>Listen</b>	Using our ears to hear other people.
<b>Pray</b>	An action where we talk to God.
<b>Mass</b>	When a Parish gathers together to praise Jesus.
<b>Sing</b>	An action we can do by ourselves or in a group, using our voice to make a sound, sometimes with music.
<b>Gather</b>	Coming together in one place.
<b>Together</b>	Being with a group of people
<b>Alone</b>	Being by yourself.
<b>Lectern</b>	A stand where the Bible is placed in Church for people to read from.
<b>"The Lord be with you."</b>	Words said by the Priest in mass.
<b>"And with your Spirit."</b>	What the Parish community say back to the priest when he says "The Lord be with you."
