What should I already know?

That Advent is a time of waiting to celebrate Jesus' coming at Christmas.

What will I be learning?

- Talk about their own experience and feelings of preparing for special occasions.
- **Say** what they wonder about the amount of time and care involved in preparing for Christmas.
- **Recognise** the events around the birth of Jesus as religious stories.
- **Recognise** some religious signs and symbols and use religious words and phrases connected with the liturgical season of Advent.
- **Recognise** that Christians, through their actions follow Jesus as the Light of the . World.
- Ask and respond to their own and others, experience and feelings, about how important it is to prepare well and what happens if there is no preparation.
- Ask and respond to questions about they and others wonder about the ٠ amount of time and care involved in preparing for Christmas and realise that some of these are difficult to answer.
- Retell the stories of the Annunciation, the Visitation and the Nativity and be ٠ familiar with the characters in those events.
- Use religious words and phrases to **describe** some religious actions and symbols connected with the liturgical season of Advent.
- Describe how Christians follow Jesus as the Light of the World and live that out in their lives.

preparing	Actions we complete to get ready for an event.
Advent	The first season of the Church year, leading up to Christmas. It last for four weeks.
Christmas	A Christian festival celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ.
Nativity	The birth of Jesus Christ.
waiting	The time we spend preparing for something to happen.
Annunciation	The announcement made by the Angel Gabriel to Mary that she would have God's son, Jesus Christ.
Visitation	The visit Mary made to her cousin Elizabeth.
