What will I be learning?

- **Ask and respond** to questions about their own and others' experiences of making choices.
- **Ask questions** about what they and others wonder about how choices are made and realise that some of these questions are difficult to answer.
- **Retell** the stories of the Two Sons and the Prodigal Son.
- Use religious words and phrases to **describe** saying sorry and asking for forgiveness.
- **Describe** the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- **Describe** a simple Examination of Conscience and to write or say a sorry prayer.
- **Describe** some ways in which followers of Jesus live.
- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect their and others' decisions about choices and their consequences.
- **Compare** their own and other people's ideas about questions of choices and their consequences and realise that these questions are difficult to answer.
- **Make links** between religious stories and the belief in a loving and forgiving God.
- Use a developing religious vocabulary to begin to **give reasons** for what happens in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- **Give reasons** why particular Christians make good choices and follow Jesus.

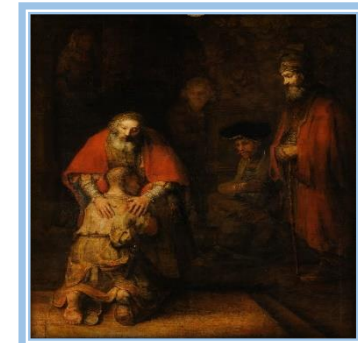
Reconciliation	Reconciliation is the act of bringing people together to be friendly again or coming to an agreement
Confession	Something confessed, especially a disclosure of one's sins to a priest for absolution.
Penance	Penance is repentance of sins
Repentance	To feel remorse for; feel sorry for; be contrite about
Penitent	A person who repents for wrongdoing. The word penitent means the person who is saying sorry.
Absolution	Freed from any question of guilt; "is absolved from all blame" The word absolution means forgiveness
Grace	A persons nature to kindness and compassion Grace is the free gift of God's love
