Amen

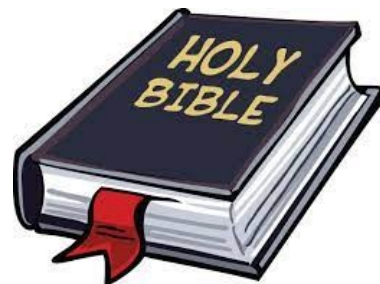
Lunchtime Prayer
