What should I already know?

That Lent is a time to change in preparation for the celebration of Easter.

What will I be learning?

- To recognise some religious signs and symbols of Ash Wednesday, Lent and Easter Sunday and use some religious words and phrases.
- To recognise that people use the opportunity of Lent to change and make a new start.
- To ask and respond to questions about their own and others' experience and feelings about how we can change.
- To retell the stories of Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
- To use religious words and phrases to describe some religious actions and symbols of Ash Wednesday, Lent and Easter Sunday.
- To describe how Christians choose to use the opportunity of Lent to change.

change	Make something different.
season	The year is spilt into four seasons: Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn.
spring	A season of the year which provides new life after the cold winter.
growth	Where a animal or plant gets bigger.
Lent	The 40 days and 40 nights before Easter.
Ash Wednesday	A holy day of prayer and fasting.
Good Friday	The day Jesus died on the cross.
Easter Sunday	The day Jesus rose from the dead.
Alleluia	A special word of thanksgiving.
Cross	Made from two pieces of wood to make a cross.
Resurrection	Jesus coming back to life.
