What should I already know?

Children will have experienced celebrations at home.

What will I be learning?

- I will begin to **recognise** that the church/parish family celebrate in particular ways.

Key Words

Church	a group of people called together to worship Jesus and God. This can be done in a building known as a Church.
Priest	A man whose job it is to tell and teach people about God and Jesus Christ his son.
Celebrate	Mark a special event with a gathering or special activity.
Celebrating	The action of marking a special event or occasion.
Parish family	A group of people belonging to a Church in a local area.
Family	People who are related to each other.
Community	People who live or work in an area together.
Celebration	The event that is used to mark a special occasion.
Party	A celebration of an event.
Memory	Something remembered that has already happened.
Father	A man who has a child, for example God is Jesus' Father.
Altar	A special table in a Church.
Temple	A place where Jewish people go to pray and worship God.
parish	A local area of a Church community.
