What will I be learning?

- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect their own and others' quality of care and commitment towards each other.
- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect their own and others' behaviour in relationships.
- Use a **developing religious vocabulary** to **give reasons** for the religious actions and symbols used in the Sacrament of Marriage.
- **Give reasons** for the love and service shown by Christians.
- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect their behaviour and that of others, concerning their mission in life.
- **Begin to compare** their own and other people's ideas about questions concerning care and commitment that are difficult to answer.

- **Begin to describe and show understanding** of religious sources, beliefs, ideas, feelings and experiences making links between them; concerning the mission of a Christian and married people in particular.
- **Use religious terms** to **begin to show an understanding** of the marriage liturgy and the Promises made.
- **Begin to show understanding** of how religious belief shapes the lives of married people.
- **Begin to show understanding** of how religious belief shapes the lives of those who are involved in the community as volunteers.
