Advent	A season in the Church's year where we are waiting the arrival of Jesus.

Joseph	Mary's husband
Swaddling clothes	A type of blanket or clothing that would be wrapped around a baby.
Manger	A long container, usually made of wood where horses of cattle (cows) would feed. Jesus was laid in a manger when he was born in a stable.
Crib	A traditional bed for a baby.
Shepherds	People whose job it is to look after flocks of sheep.
Wise men	Men who were very wise and studied the stars to help to tell them about
