| creation | The <u>act</u> of <u>creating</u> something, or the thing that is <u>created</u> . |
| Shabbat | Jews often call the day Shabbat, which is Hebrew for Sabbath, and which comes from the Hebrew word for rest. |
| Challah | The term challah originally referred to a kind of cake. |
| hydalah | Hydalah is a Jewish religious ceremony that marks the end of Shabbat and users in a new week. |
| Spice box | It is a box to keep fragrant spices in. |
| kiddush | Kiddush is a blessing recited over wine or grape juice to sanctify the Shabbat and Jewish holidays. |
