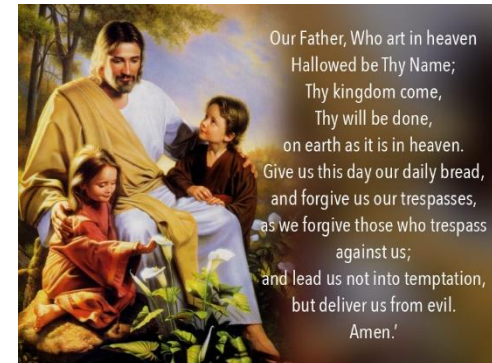
What makes some meals special?

Key Words

family	A group of people related to each other.
meal	Food that you eat.
Mass	Is a religious service which celebrate the Eucharist.
share	A part of a portion of a larger amount.
blessing	A gift bestowed by God.
bread	I a staple food prepared from a dough of flour and water usually baked.
host	Consecrated bread.
wine	A drink made from wine.
altar	A special table where bread and wine are consecrated.
Last Supper	The last meal Jesus shared with his disciples before he died.
Holy Communion	The celebration of the bread and wine being made holy.
Preparation of the Gifts	The offertory of the mass.
litany	A special prayer that is used in the mass.
chalice	A special cup where the wine is consecrated.
