### What should I already know?

**Pentecost, spreading the Gospel message through the gift of the Holy Spirit.**

### What will I be learning?

- Ask and respond to questions about their own and others' experiences and feelings about the power of fire and wind and how this energy can be used for good.
- Ask questions about what they and others' wonder about the power of wind and fire and realise that some of these questions are difficult to answer.
- Retell the story of the Ascension and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
- Use religious words and phrases to describe what happened to the apostles at Pentecost, what they saw and felt.
- Describe some ways in which Christians live when they use the energy and gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- Compare their own and other people's ideas about questions that are difficult to answer about the best use of the power of wind and fire.
- Make links between the Pentecost story and Christian belief in the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Give reasons for the love Christians show because they are inspired by the Holy Spirit.
