What will I be learning?


- **Ask and respond** to questions of their own and others' experience and feelings of how people give themselves for others.
- **Ask and respond** to questions about the courageousness of giving and realise that some questions are difficult to answer.
- **Retell** some of the stories of Holy Week and the Resurrection.
- Use religious words and phrases to **describe** the religious actions and symbols of Lent and Holy Week.
- **Describe** some ways in which Christians use the time of Lent to give to others.
- **Make links** to show how feelings and beliefs affect their own and others' attitude to giving of themselves.
- **Make links** between the scripture and what Christians believe about how they should act.
- **Give reasons** given by Christians for being kind and generous, especially during Lent.


